Q: When is the deadline to submit my application?

A: All materials must be submitted together and postmarked no later than March 3, 2025. DO NOT mail application Registered Mail or any other method that requires a signature as all mail arrives at a P. O. Box. Requiring a signature for delivery may delay your application or cause it to be returned to the sender by the Post Office. No Email submissions will be accepted.

Q: Who can apply?

A: Applicants must be a Military Dependent I.D. card holder. Scholarships will be awarded in the following categories: High School Senior, Continuing Education (i.e. Vocational, Associate, Undergraduate, Graduate), Spouse.

Q: What do I need?

A: 1. High School students and first time college students: a sealed, official high school/GED transcript, the completed DATA sheet, an essay, original copies of two (2) letters of recommendations and a copy of the college entrance exam scores.

2. Continuing and Graduate Education students: an official, sealed copy of college transcripts, completed DATA sheet, an essay, original copies of two (2) letters of recommendations, official high school transcript if it's your first year in college.

Q: When will I find out if my application was approved?

A: All applicants will be notified by mail of the outcome of the scholarship awards before the academic year begins.

Q: How many letters of recommendation do I need?

A: Please submit two (2) original copies of letters of recommendation.

Q: Can you tell me more about the essay?

A: This essay must include the following topics: your educational plans, your personal ambitions and goals, and why you feel you would be a worthy recipient of this scholarship. The essay should be a minimum of 500 typed written words. Please submit your essay on a separate sheet of paper labeled with your name. Be creative, tell us how important being apart if the military community has helped you become the leader you are today! We know military life isn't easy but we want to hear about how you captivated the hard times and turned them into something amazing! Good luck!
